MISSION

The mission of KIPP Through College is for all students to have the access, skills and resources necessary to navigate to and through college into self-sufficient adulthood. The KTC team, therefore, provides structured support focused on college readiness, persistence, and completion until the day alumni receive their college degree.

SERVICES

High School Transition Services

Seventh and eighth grade students and their families are provided with access to college knowledge and support in matriculating to local KIPP high schools.

College Advising

Eleventh and twelfth graders are provided with college knowledge and academic advising through workshops and meetings. All twelfth graders work closely with KTC Advisors who guide students through the college application process - from researching the right college match and completing applications to accessing scholarships and enrolling in college.

Alumni Advising

KTC Alumni Advisors support alumni in college by tracking academic progress, connecting students to services on and off campus, and helping alumni stay linked to their KIPP family through outreach, campus cohorts, events and the network of KIPP schools that span the country.

National Initiatives

KIPP COLLEGE ACCOUNT



The KIPP College Account program provides participating students and families with college readiness curriculum, matched college savings accounts, and financial literacy workshops for parents.

FUTURE FOCUS PROGRAM



Through a partnership with Accenture, Future Focus is a college and career readiness program designed for KIPP high school students and alumni. The program provides career readiness opportunities, such as workshops, job shadowing, and internships.
