In response to local neighbor concerns, KIPP Bay Area Schools has modified the design plans for the KIPP King Collegiate campus. We invite you to a Community Meeting on Tuesday, October 20, to view these revised plans and ask any questions you may have about the campus construction project.

We have also constituted a Working Committee composed of community representatives to create an open dialogue about the campus expansion and ensure those interested remain well-informed and well represented. The Working Group is composed of the following:

The Working Committee will formally introduce themselves and serve as ongoing representation for constituent groups through the remainder of this project. Their participation on our working committee is not an indication of agreement and/or alignment with KIPP and our plans for the expansion project. They are working in cooperation with us to ensure your voices are heard.

Lastly, we are revising and reissuing the Mitigated Negative Declaration CEQA Report with the new design modifications. As such, we will enter a new 30 day public review period to ensure all interested parties have sufficient time to review and consider the draft CEQA report with the new design modifications. We will provide a full update on this timeline at the Community Meeting and it will likewise be posted on our website.
